The successful applicant will continue to build our womens playing group to incorporate 2 women's teams in Premier Cricket and progress the implementation of a junior development academy and program. In our current playing group we have an Aust/State player, under age State representatives, international experienced recruits (India and Ireland) and other players with significant enthusiasm for learning the skills of cricket.
